

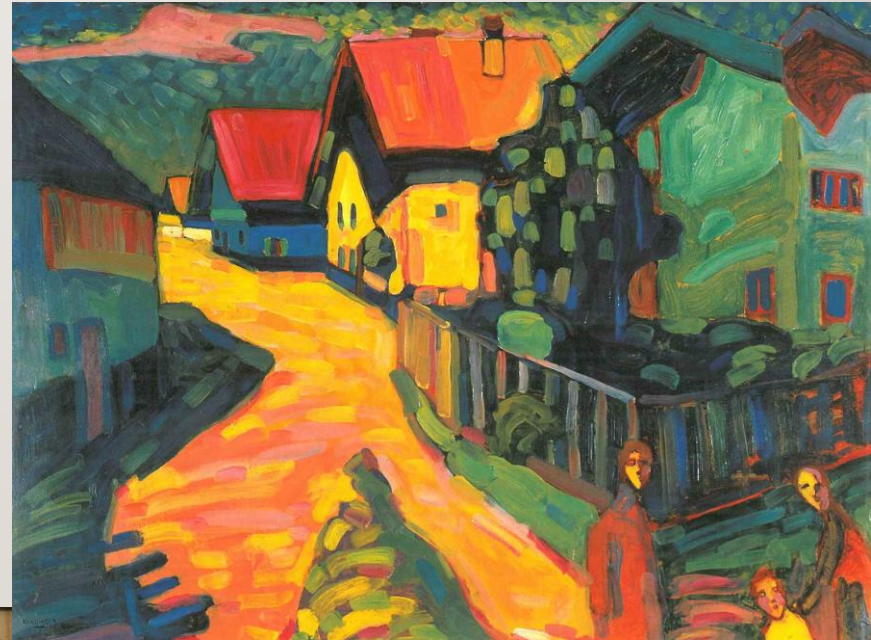

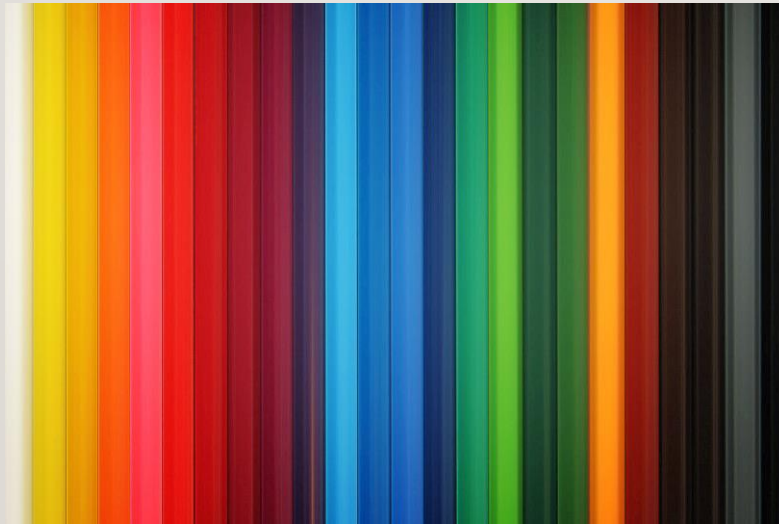
ANALYSIS
